

Emerging Artist Gallery PROSPECTUS

The **Emerging Artist Gallery at the MANN Center for the Arts** celebrates the diverse artwork of North Carolina artists in two-dimensional (wall hanging) mediums. Artwork may be of any style or genre (such as landscapes, portraiture, still life) but must meet the conditions of entry in this prospectus for consideration. Up to three artists may be chosen to display together in a two-month collection.

IMPORTANT DATES

Entry Deadlines: Artists may apply for participation at any time. To be considered for the next exhibition, applications must be received a minimum of two months in advance.

Accepted artists will be notified a minimum of one month prior to exhibition. Artists may be accepted for participation in the next available show or for future exhibitions based on availability.

Art Intake: generally one week prior to exhibition dates

Art Pickup: generally one week after exhibition dates

ENTRY FEE

There is no fee to enter.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Artist must be a resident of North Carolina or have a studio with a permanent address in North Carolina.
- Artists must be 18 years of age or older by the date of their application, not be employed as professional artists, and have not shown a solo collection in another NC-based art gallery. Limited exhibition experience in a group show, fair competition or art event/auction are acceptable.
- All artwork must be original fine art quality conceived and created solely by the entering artist. AI-generated artwork or giclees of original art are not accepted.
- All artwork must be appropriate for a family audience, and not all artwork will be accepted.
- The Gallery shows two-dimensional works only, and all artwork must be framed or gallery wrapped and ready to hang. Photographic entries may be framed or printed on mediums suitable for hanging.
- At minimum, 75% of art displayed must be available for purchase.
- MANN Center for the Arts handles sales from the exhibition and retains a 30% commission from all sales.
- All artwork remains on display through the exhibition dates unless otherwise noted.
- Artists must provide the Gallery Price for their artwork, in whole dollar amounts. ***There is no price adjustment permitted after art intake.***

ARTIST PAYMENTS: Payment of the net sale proceeds (sale price, less commission) will be processed via check at the end of the exhibition. Check will be mailed to the Artist address on file or delivered directly to the Artist.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: Artist assumes responsibility for safely delivering or shipping artwork to/from the Center. The Center is not responsible for damage in delivery or shipping. Entries will be handled and stored with care. The submission of art to the exhibition shall imply an agreement on the part of the Artist to the conditions set forth in this Prospectus and in the *Works on Consignment Agreement*. The Artist consents to the use of his/her name and artwork image(s) for purposes of promotion and advertisement by MANN Center for the Arts. All decisions made by the Gallery Curator are final.
